Class Activities will include the followings:

i) Topical Re-teaching

The topical re-teaching will cover the explanation of economics terms, process development of main economic arguments, discussion on evaluation and analysis of economic implication and policies. Students will also be taught on how to understand, apply and retain the knowledge taught.

ii) Essay Discussion

Students will be taught on how to apply economics knowledge to the requirement of the question, structural development and paragraph development on economic causation, graphical illustration, description of graphs, comparative and analytical evaluation of the questions.

iii) CSQ Discussion

Students will be taught on how to explain trend analysis, develop causation with the extraction of data and figures from the extracts and tables and make analysis and evaluation with the information by linking them to the requirement of the question.

iv) Class Practices for CSQ and Essays

Students are to attempt Essay and CSQ questions during lessons. These trial practices will enable the students to develop spontaneous thinking skills and improve their writing capacity to attempt questions within the stipulated time. Students' answers will be marked and reviewed by the tutor, pointing out their errors in explanation, development of answers and application of knowledge.
